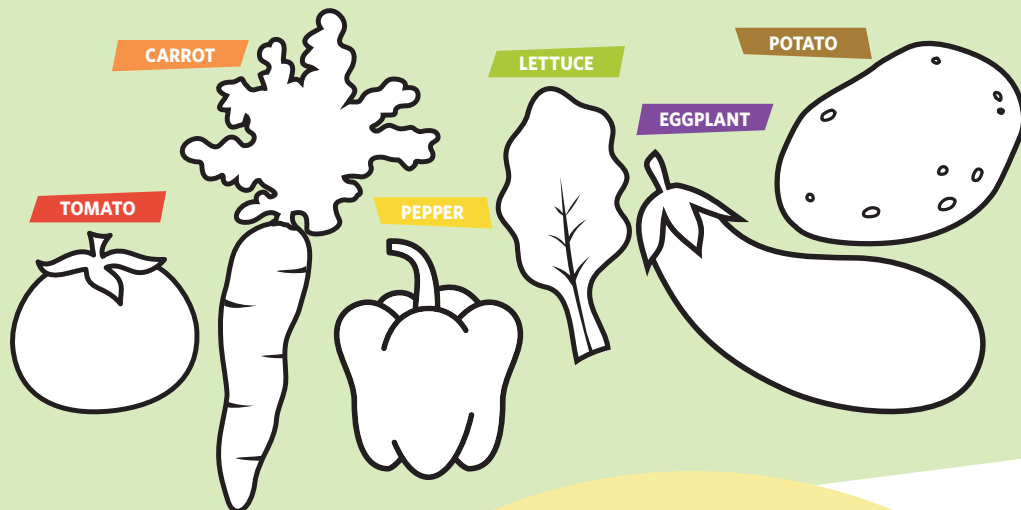


YOUR FRIENDS, THE VEGGIES!

OUTDOORS




GROW IT!

Do you want to try gardening? Try this to get started!

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1 Make some cotton balls wet (but not soggy).
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2 Take seeds from raw fruits and veggies, like melons, tomatoes and peppers, and put them on the cotton balls. Make sure each one won't fall off. Try different seeds on different cotton balls.
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3 Put the cotton balls and seeds in a clear plastic bag, then seal the bag. Label the bag so you know what seeds are in there!
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4 Tape the bag to a window. Pick one that gets lots of light all day.



Now, wait! See if your seed starts to grow. You should see roots and leaves in a couple of days. You can take a picture every day. When they get big enough, you can put the plants into flowerpots with some dirt and see if they get even bigger!
