
MAKE IT!

- 1 Find a thin piece of cardboard, like from a cereal box. Put a dollar bill on it and trace the bill with a pencil. Then give the dollar back!

- 2 Cut along the lines you made so you have a long cardboard rectangle.



- 3 Decorate the cardboard any way you like—with words or pictures or designs. You can use paper, crayons and markers, shiny foil, or fun stickers. Make sure it stays thin and flat, and don't use paint or glitter... unless you want those in your books!



- 4 Use a hole-puncher or pencil to make a hole near the top of your bookmark. Then tie a ribbon, piece of yarn, or tassel through it... and you're done!
