

Even though Shabbat comes every week, how much do you think about it? Well, think now! It's time to see what you know. Answers are on the bottom of the page.

# MAKE IT!

In many homes, we say a *bracha* (blessing) over the wine or grape juice while the challah is covered with a small, pretty cloth. Then we remove the cloth when it's the challah's turn for a blessing.

- 1 Find an old piece of cloth, like a shirt, scarf, or pillowcase no one is using. Make sure you ask first!
- 2 Using a ruler to measure, cut a square that is one foot long on all sides.
- 3 Decorate it! You can paint or color it, glue or sew ribbons and buttons on it, draw pictures—whatever you like. Many challah covers have the word Shabbat in Hebrew (see below).
- 4 Make sure the paint, marker, or glue is dry before you put your challah cover on your yummy challah!
